- ☐ Korea Environment Corporation(KECO) intends to support a Full-course Support Program for the registration of Phase 3 existing chemical substances(10-100 t/a).
- ☐ In this regard, Representative of existing chemical substance consortium(CICO) who wish to receive benefits from Full-course Support Program are requested to refer to the following information and apply for the demand survey.
- ☐ Demand Survey Overview
 - (Support Subject) All of the following conditions must be met
 - (1) A CICO that includes members treating Phase 3 grace period substances.
 - (2) At least one small- or medium-sized enterprise(SME) and mid-sized enterprise among the CICO's members.
 - (3) A CICO where both the representative and the members

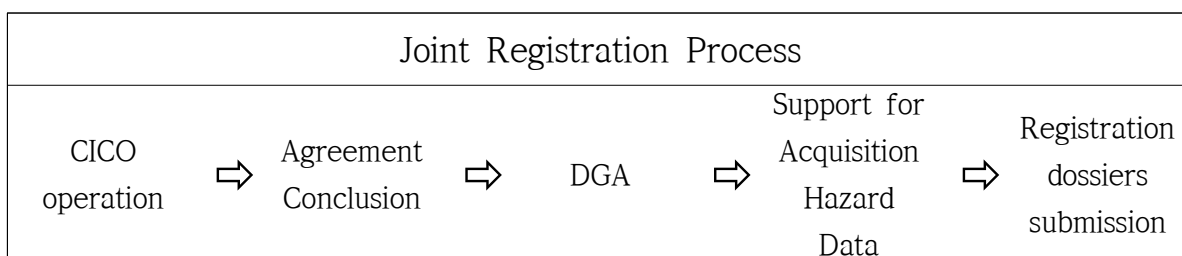
can be verified.

<Ref.> Exclusion Criteria

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| <p>A. Substances that have been registered and gotten supported are not subject to support.</p> <p>B. CICO where the consulting firm is a representative is not subject to support.</p> <p>C. Big company and representatives who appointed as OR of overseas manufactures or producers must cover the consulting costs themselves.</p> |

- Full-course support from CICO management to submission of registration dossiers.

○ Supporting for registration consultation

- CICO operation, Substance Identification Profile, DGA, Acquiring Hazard Data, CSR Preparation, Collecting Exposure Scenario, Preparing registration dossiers

〈Notes〉

- (1) Eligible CICO must report to the KECO a detailed breakdown of total cost incurred throughout the joint registration process, including expenses related to data acquisition (purchase, generation), production, and administrative fees. This information may be disclosed publicly in the future.
- (2) Eligible CICO must utilize government-supported tool and resources, Hazard Information Database, K-Chesar, ESD&T and etc.
- (3) The result from exposure scenario preparation will be used to develop a “Exposure Scenario Guide”, which will be distributed to the industry in the future. (Confidential business information(CBI) will be excluded.)
- (4) Active member, including the representative, may not request additional compensation from passive member beyond the actual costs incurred for the registration process.

(4) Confirmation Letter of Small- and Medium-sized or Mid-sized company.(Issued after this survey date)

※ Document (2), (3), (4) must be completed according to the provided templates and attached

○ (Selection)

- Prioritizing based on the evaluation criteria after confirming compliance with the support criteria.
- Applicants may be excluded from selection based on support criteria, support budget, and review.

※ Evaluation criteria : proportion of SMEs, number of SMEs, proportion of manufacturers, etc.

○ (Announcement) The selection results will be published on the Industrial Support Center website.

□ Check List

- If the submitted documents are incomplete, KECO may request supplementary, and the application may be excluded from selection.
- If false or deception documents are submitted, the selection will be canceled.
- If the applicant withdraws from the support project or if any false or deception information is found in the submitted documents, participation in future support projects conducted

may be restricted.

- The selected representative of CICO must notify to members that the substance has been selected for the support project and must include the following details in the CICO agreement, which must be submitted to KECO.

※ The agreement must specify the registered tonnage of members

<List must be reflected in the Agreement>

- (1) No additional consulting fees will be charged to SME among AM
- (2) If SMEs among AM jointly prepare CSR, the preparation cost will not be charged regardless of the number of ES (Includes all cases that the jointly prepared CSR is reproduced and submitted).
- (3) If PM requests a detailed registration costs, all related expenses will be revealed along with the support details from Existing Chemical Substance Full-course Support Program.

- CICO representative and members selected for the support program must truly carry out their tasks. If any issues are found in project execution, the selection may be canceled.
- Any Only Representative(OR) by an overseas manufacturer/producer within the CICO will not be considered an SMEs, regardless of its actual company size.

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
